GETTING THE PERFECT SHOT



DO'S AND DON'TS

- Using your phone? Hold the phone horizontally, and keep your hands as still as possible.
- Check the focus. Is your camera focusing on the main subject of your image or somewhere else? Low light or wiggly children can make photos blurry.
- Avoid taking photos with clothing or objects that have visible logos, cartoon or video characters, or inappropriate sayings on them.
- Avoid using your camera's built-in flash; it washes out the image and creates dark outlines and casts shadows. If your photo or video is too dark, try adding more light by opening blinds or moving closer to a window.
- When taking pictures inside, try adding more natural light by opening blinds or moving closer to a window.
- Avoid distracting or cluttered backgrounds. Make sure the action is the focus of the image.

ACCEPTABLE FORMATS

MSGCU accepts photos in JPEG, TIF, or EPS formats.

PHOTO RELEASES
